# All the Basics

## *Location*

The University Health Center, located on Campus Drive across from Stamp Student Union, is a nationally accredited ambulatory health care facility. Every registered student living on- or off-campus is eligible to use the University Health Center (UHC).

## *Hours*

Monday - Friday: 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.  
Saturday: 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.  
Sunday: Closed

Hours vary during university holidays and winter/summer sessions. Visit the website for up-to-date information.

Students are seen by appointment for routine care between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays. A limited number of same day appointments are available. Medical services are limited after 5 p.m. and on Saturdays. Urgent Care services are available without an appointment. The **After Hours NurseLine** (301.314.9386), a free medical advice and information service, is available to registered students when the UHC is closed.

## *Services*

The following services are available at the UHC: Primary Care, Urgent Care, men's and women's reproductive health care, pharmacy, acupuncture, massage therapy, HIV testing, sports medicine, nutrition, mental health, eating disorders, substance abuse, travel clinic, occupational health, health promotion, and

Victim Assistance. Dental Health Services at the University Health Center are provided by the University of Maryland, School of Dentistry. The Center for Health and Wellbeing (CHWB), a satellite of the UHC located in the Eppley Recreation Center, is open 12 p.m. to 8 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and 12p.m. to 5 p.m., Friday. The CHWB provides health promotion programs and services. It does not provide medical services.

## *Fees*

There is a \$10 fee for visits with most of our providers. Fees may vary depending on the type of service. There is also a "Missed Appointment/Late Cancellation" fee. To avoid the charge, appointments must be cancelled or rescheduled at least 24 hours in advance. Some departments schedule their own appointments. Additional fees are charged for services such as: dental health, laboratory, radiology, immunizations, allergy injections, casts, physical therapy, medications and supplies dispensed through the pharmacy and medical units, massage, acupuncture, substance abuse counseling, and various medical procedures and orthopedic supplies. Charges are posted to the student's Bursar Account or can be paid at the time of visit in the UHC. Charges paid for at the time of visit will not appear on the Bursar Account.

## *Treatment Consent and Confidentiality*

Students younger than 18 will need to submit a form giving permission from a parent or legal guardian to be treated, except for mental health and sexual health services. To obtain a form, call 301-314-8180 or visit the Health Center's web site.

For students 18 and older, treatment information cannot be given to parents without the student's written consent or through a court ordered subpoena. Information regarding mental health or sexual health services cannot be released without the patient's consent. The UHC is compliant with the Federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act.

## Health Insurance

The University Health Center (UHC) strongly recommends that all students have health insurance. The University of Maryland Student Health Insurance Plan provides coverage for accidents and illness on and off campus. Students may sign up for the Student Health Insurance Plan during the open enrollment periods at the beginning of each semester. Information about the Student Health Insurance Plan can be obtained from the UHC website or by visiting the UHC Business Office.

The University Health Center is not a participating provider with any other insurance company. Students are directly responsible for payment of all fees. Upon written request, the UHC Business Office will provide appropriately coded bills for patients seeking reimbursement from insurance companies.

## Pharmacy Plans

The pharmacy accepts many major pharmacy plans. If you would like to bring your pharmacy card to the Health Center Pharmacy while you are on campus during orientation or at another time, the information can be entered into the pharmacy's system.

## Immunization Requirements

The University of Maryland requires ALL students (including: credit/non-credit, degree/non-degree seeking, full/part/half-time, undergraduate, graduate, transfer, International, Golden ID or other student status) to provide proof of immunization dates for: Measles, Mumps and Rubella (M.M.R., 2 doses) **PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES.**

The *Immunization Record* must be submitted to the University Health Center. Students may bring the completed form to orientation, or it can be faxed to 301-314-5234. The form is available on-line: [www.health.umd.edu/forms/](http://www.health.umd.edu/forms/)

All International students must document: Measles, Mumps and Rubella (M.M.R., 2 doses) Immunizations and Tuberculosis (TB) test completed within the past 6 months.

Maryland State Law requires students living in campus owned housing to receive the meningitis vaccine or sign a waiver stating they have chosen not to receive the vaccine. For more information, visit the website, email [health@umd.edu](mailto:health@umd.edu), or call 301.314.8180.

Students who fail to submit proof of MMR immunization, signed by a physician or acceptable alternative documentation, will be prohibited from registering for classes after a one-semester grace period.

## Emergencies

If students have a health emergency when the Health Center is closed, they should call 911. The University is not responsible for care provided off campus. A list of local hospital information is available. The UHC assumes no financial responsibility for care received off campus.
